

Twilight Series Race 4 – 6th June – Pursuit

The forecast was good, being dry with South/South East wind. At Netley the wind was exactly 15 knots from the South. We decided to set up with Deans Lake as the windward mark. During the hour before the start, the wind backed 60 degrees and stayed there. We moved the start to just south of Netley with After Barn as the windward mark. A clockwise course to Deans Lake gave a run down to Royal Southampton with a reach to a laid mark between Netley and Hovercraft 1 (due to low water spring tide) for the first round. After that, the two windward/leewards rounds had to be shortened due to the wind dropping to 8 knots by 8pm leaving us with little choice but to shorten at Netley.
